**All courses require pre-registration** (excluding drop-in times).

#### **To Register**

#### **INTRODUCTION TO WOODWORKING**

For men and women who want to learn the safe use of hand and power tools while making 2 projects. You will learn to use woodworking machinery and power tools, measuring, fasteners, basic joinery and shop safety. Materials will be supplied, the cost is \$45 to \$85 and will be discussed at the first class. The Safety Card will be given upon completion of this course.

#### **WOODWORKING II**

*Prerequisite : Intro to Woodworking course.*

You select your own project and provide your materials. This is an opportunity to learn new skills while completing a project of your choosing under the guidance of a qualified instructor. You will also learn advanced joinery and fastening techniques. This course may be repeated as any times as you desire. Safety Card required for this course.

## **BASEBOARDS AND CASINGS**

Learn the secrets of cutting and fitting baseboards and door and window casings (trim) for a professional-looking finish. Try your hand at cutting a coped joint for inside corners. Safety Card not required for this course.

## **ROUTER ESSENTIALS**

Bring your own router (in good working order) or use one of ours. Course will cover types of routers, router tables, collets, bases, bits, how to hold and safety operate the router. Techniques and jigs for routing dados, rabbets, dovetails, joinery, and edge decoration. There is an \$3 materials fee, payable at first class. Demonstration and hands-on. Safety Card not required for this course.

## **WOOD INLAY Level 2**

Prerequisite: Wood Inlay Level 1 Course

This is the next step in learning to do wood inlays. You will learn the advanced technique of making “constructs” where intricate pieces are preassembled before inlaying into your piece. Materials will be supplied and there will be a \$20 materials fee payable to the instructor. Please bring your inlay knife. This course is taught by George Stevens and Jamie Almond, authors of *The Art of Wood Inlay*. Safety Card Not required for this course.

## **INTRODUCTION TO WOODTURNING (Lathe)**

This one-night course is offered in partnership with the Woodturning Association of Manitoba and will introduce participants the the basics of using the woodturning lathe. You will learn to use tools, such as gouges, skewers and scrapers to turn wood objects such as spindles, bowls and pens. This is a hands-on class. Tools and supplies provided to complete a simple woodturning. Safety Card not required for this course.

### **\*NEW\* Build a Moxon Vice**

A Moxon Vice is a portable vice that can be clamped to any work surface. It is an excellent addition for woodworkers who don't already have a face vice, or who don't have a dedicated workbench. Students will learn how to cut your own dowels and various methods for threading wood. This course will employ both power and hand tools. Students should wear workshop appropriate clothing and shoes, and may bring their own PPE. Materials will be supplied (\$40 materials cost). Safety card not required.

### **CARVE YOUR OWN CANOE PADDLE**

Learn about different paddle shapes, grips and construction methods. Choose to carve a Beavertail, Ottertail or Sugar island paddle. Students will be taught the proper use and setup of a bandsaw, spindle sander and belt sander; but the majority of the work will be done by hand, using the block plane, spokeshave and rasp. This is a hands-on class that will be mildly strenuous, requiring some forearm strength and endurance to be successful. Materials will be supplied (\$40 materials cost). Safety Card not required for this course.

### **WOOD SHOP SAFETY ORIENTATION**

For experienced woodworkers who would like to use the wood shop on a drop-in basis. This one time class will acquaint you with the safety procedures of the wood shop and the safety concerns with each major piece of equipment. The Safety Card will be given upon completion of this course.

## **WOOD SHOP DROP-IN**

Drop-ins are open to anyone who is willing to obtain a Safety Card by attending the Wood Shop Safety Orientation or taking an Introduction to Woodworking class. Bring your own materials and supplies and use our wood shop space and equipment. Fee applies to whole block of time, no matter how long you stay. A knowledgeable volunteer will supervise the drop-in time to ensure equipment is used in a safe manner.
